- 1.) Drainlayers shall not commence any work until it is confirmed with the Engineering Department that the \$4,000.00 sewer entry fee and all outstanding availability fees have been paid.
- 2.) Drainlayers shall be responsible for abiding by the Town of Wilbraham's Sewer Rules and Regulations. A copy of these Rules and Regulations can be obtained in the Engineering Department.
- 3.) Drainlayers acknowledge that the installation and use of sump pumps are illegal in Wilbraham and they will be held accountable.
- 4.) The \$40.00 sewer connection fee shall be paid a minimum of one working day in advance of the inspection.
- 5.) Drainlayers are responsible for notifying the Wilbraham Water Department at 596-2826 forty-eight hours in advance to mark out any water lines prior to beginning work.
- 6.) The Wilbraham Engineering Department is no longer inspecting sanitary sewer connections without twenty-four hours prior notice.
- 7.) Failure to observe these regulations may result in loss of your drainlayer's license.
